THE HUMAN UNION

We Europeans see *mankind* as the focal point of our view of the world.

We Europeans believe in *freedom, equality* and *justice* for all.

We Europeans act in a *sustainable* fashion for the *good* of all.

THE RESPONSIBLE UNION

Europe is committed to the *peace* and *security* of its peoples.

Europe is characterized by a *cultural variety* based on *shared principles*.

Europe ensures *humane, social living conditions*.

THE DEMOCRATIC UNION

FREEDOM

1. EUROPE – The Continent of Joint Principles.

For human rights. For co-determination and equal treatment for all. For contentment brought about by social justice, balance and responsibility. For rational thinking and cultural pluralism. For the separation of state and religion.

2. EUROPE – The Continent of Great Variety.

For individual freedom. For a culturally diverse, multi-confessional and multi-lingual society. For acceptance and appreciation of the differences between all people.

3. EUROPE – The Federal Continent.

For a federal association of states with a joint structure. For a supranational identity. For sovereign, democratic rule of law.

SECURITY

The primary duty of Europe's political representatives is to *implement human values*. The aim is to achieve *humanity* and the *unequivocal recognition of human dignity*.

SOLIDARITY

Leads to a *joint future* for the people of Europe by:

- Laying down *equal rights* and *duties* for all;
- Encouraging *development* by the use of *variety*;
